



SUMMARY: Protocols employed in the return to work after CV-19

WD has made considerable investments in response to the COVID-19 challenge and we believe the following changes will ensure the safety of our patients and the WD team to allow us to now provide routine dentistry for all our patients.

1. Pre-visit and pre-treatment arrival screening
2. Patients are asked to wear face coverings, masks are available @ reception if patients do not have one.
3. Patients attend on their own unless children or vulnerable adults
4. Temperature screening and anti-viral mouth rinse on arrival with hypochlorous acid
5. Maintaining social distancing of 2 metres and hand washing
6. Water supply cleaning
7. Visors, gowns and masks. (Standard mask, visor, disposable apron in non-AGP and FFP2 mask (fit checked), visor and disposable/re-usable full length gown in AGP)
8. Rubber dam usage wherever possible.
9. Increased air changes/ hour achieved by air exchange systems and open windows.
10. High Volume Suction. Certified by engineers @ >250 litres/hour
11. Air Purifiers. Delivering a Clean Air Delivery Rate (CADR) of 450 m³
12. Disinfectant fogging of clinical areas after AGP with Hypochlorous acid
13. Compliant cleaning to HTM-0105 best practice standards with hypochlorous acid and chlorine dioxide based disinfectant solutions
